CIRCULAR

During a meeting with the stakeholders consisting of the representatives of Ministry of Women and Child Development (MoWCD) Govt. of India, National Commission of Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR), National Commission for Women (NCW), Delhi Commission for Protection of Child Rights (DCPCR), "Delhi Commission for Women" (DCW), Delhi Legal Service Authority (DLSA) NGOs working in children and women field and Addl. DCsP of Districts, ACsP/CAW Cells and officers from Anti Human Trafficking Units (AHTU), the issue of the possibility of trafficking of orphaned children was extensively discussed and the following points emerged :-

1. The dedicated universal Helpline No. 1098 is available which is being monitored by Ministry of Women and Child Development (MoWCD), Govt. of India to report any such instances.
2. If any child is found who needs care and protection, it should immediately be reported on Child Helpline No. 1098.
3. It was further decided that a lawful procedure has already been established regarding adoption as per JJ Act-2015 which should be followed. If any such instance comes in knowledge where any irregularity is noticed regarding adoption of an orphan child by anyone it should be immediately informed to the nearest police station to initiate action.
4. In every case where any orphan child is found, he/she is to be produced before concerned Child Welfare Committee. The committee will pass appropriate order for rehabilitation of the orphaned child as per lawful procedure.

It is therefore, enjoined on all the Police Stations and Police Posts to prominently display Helpline No. 1098, 181 and 112 and its purpose.
